DRESS CODE

This is a schooling show and SEAHA's goal is to provide a safe environment for your training opportunities.

HELMETS are **REQUIRED** WHEN RIDING BAREBACK AND

WHILE JUMPING, both inside and outside the Main Arena.

Western Requirements—Riding helmet/Western Hat, boots, collared shirt (sleeves preferred). NO "Fat Baby" boots. Chaps optional.

RULES

(This is an abbreviated version. Please refer to Official SEAHA Horse Show Rules.)

1. The Judge's decision is final.
2. SEAHA reserves the right to combine classes.
3. This show adheres to the rules set forth in the SEAHA Handbook and USEF.
4. A 1 minute gate call will be enforced.
5. Tack changes must be requested AT LEAST 1 class prior to time needed.
6. Helmets are **REQUIRED** for all jumping and bareback classes.
7. Exhibitors entering the Walk/Trot classes **MAY NOT** cross-enter into canter/lope classes.
8. The age of an Exhibitor is determined by the age on the 1st of January.
9. **Maiden Horse or Rider-Open** to any Horse or Rider who has **never** won a Blue Ribbon
10. **Novice Horse or Rider-Open** to any Horse or Rider who has not won more than 3 blue ribbons in any division
11. **Pony- Under 14 Hands**
12. **Stallions** may only be shown by exhibitors 18 years and older.
13. **Driving Exhibitors 14 and under** must be accompanied in the cart by an adult.
14. **NO REFUNDS** on scratched classes.
15. No Tapadero-style stirrups.
16. No "Fat Baby" boots allowed
